ID: Buff/brownish disc/cup-shaped growths on bark.

Habitat: Scattered. On bark of hardwoods (oaks, elms, hophornbeam).

Fruiting Body: 1/32-1/16" thick [1-1.5 mm]

Disc-shaped; becoming fused. Fertile surface: Buff-pink (brownish & somewhat powdery in age); elevated, incurved margin. Sterile surface: White, hairy.

Spores: Hyaline.

Frequency: Common.

Locations: CENPK, DANPV, GONRA, HAMVL, HENPV, MCHPV, MPENA, MURHL, OTHER, PATBT, PIGTL, ROBNC, SAVMT, SLMLP, WINTR.
