ID: Cap gray-brown w/ grayish-white flocculose warts; convex. Stalk w/ bulb showing gray hairs/fibrous-scaly volval remains.

Habitat: Scattered, groups. On ground in mixed forests.

Cap: 2 – 4" [5 – 10 cm]

Gray-brown (grayer w/ age). Convex (flatter in age). Covered w/gray/grayish-white flocculose warts. Margin often lighter. Flesh white.

Gills: White. Free. Crowded.

Spores: *White*. Subglobose/broadly elliptical, smooth.

Stalk: 2 – 4" [5 – 10 cm] x 0.3 – 0.8" [8 – 20 mm]

White. White ring. Clavate/bulbous bulb w/ white/light gray hairs/fibrous scaly volval remains.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: GONRA.

Notes: Mycobank 211312. Gorman Stream Valley NRA (8/4/2012) specimen verified by examination of spores by R. Solem..

Subgenus: *Amanita*.
