ID: Cap whitish-gray, convex/flat, striate margin; covered w/ powdery gray veil remnants; no ring, small bulb.

Habitat: Solitary, loosely grouped. On ground in mixed forests.

Cap: 1 – 3.1" [2.5 – 8 cm]

Whitish-gray w/ dense layer of grayish powdery outer veil. Broadly convex/flat. Grooved margin may be upturned. Flesh white, thin.

Gills: White. Free. Close. Broad.


Spores: *White*. Round/ellipsoid, smooth, hyaline.

Stalk: 1 – 3" [2.5 – 7.5 cm] x 1/8 – 3/8" [3 – 10 mm]

Dirty white. Smooth/white powder. Tapers up. No ring. Small rounded bulb; may have/ brown-gray band of volval remains.

Frequency: Very common.

Locations: BIGBR, BRNBR, DANPV, FRANF, GONRA, HAMVL, HIRIP, MANWD, MCHPV, MPENA, MURHL, OTHER, PIGTL, ROBNC, SAVPK, UMDCF, WINTR, WFRDP, WSTRP.

Notes:  **Do not taste!** Mycobank 355585. Western Regional Park and Franciscan Friars specimens identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.
