Gray-veil Amanita

ID: Cap brownish-gray (w/ possibly a few gray warts). Stalk whitish w/ gray fibers; pale gray ring; marginate bulb.

Habitat: Solitary, scattered, groups, clusters. On ground in mixed forests.

Cap: 1.8 – 4.5" [4.5 – 11.5 cm]
Dark brownish-gray (disc darker). May have a few floccose gray warts. Dry/sticky. Smooth. Margin smooth/vaguely striate. Flesh whitish.

Gills: White/pale gray. Free/attached. Close. Broad. Partial veil gray. Depth = 2X cap flesh. Secondary gills.

Spores: White. Round.

Stalk: 2 – 4.5" x 0.2 – 0.8" [5 – 11.5 cm x 6 – 18 mm]
Whitish w/ gray fibers. Nearly smooth; upper surface striate. Tapering slightly up. Pale gray ring partially adheres to stalk. Nearly round marginate bulb w distinct collar. Stuffed/hollow.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: HIRIP.
