## Hated Amanita

**ID**: Grayish-brown, disc darker w/ whitish center; brown radial streaking; whitre ring; saccate volva.

**Habitat**: Solitary, scattered. On ground in coniferous, deciduous, and mixed forests.

**Cap**: 2 – 4.3" [5 – 11 cm]

Grayish-brown, disc darker but whitish at center, brown radial streaking. Convex (nearly flat in age). Flesh white.

Gills: White. Free/slightly attached. Close/crowded. Secondary gills.

Spores: White.

**Stalk**: 2 - 4" x up to 3/4" [5 - 10 cm x 2 cm] Whitish. Finely hairy. Tapers up. White ring. Slightly enlarged base. Flaring/lobed saccate volva

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: BIGBR.
