

ID: Grayish-brown; vase-shaped in age; cap lined; margin inrolled.

Habitat: Scattered, on decaying wood in conifer or mixed forests.

Cap: 1 - 4" [2.5 - 10 cm]

None

Grayish-brown. Convex (depressed/vase-shaped in age); later lined. Smooth, hygrophanous. Margin inrolled. Flesh thin, gray.

Gills: Pale grayish-brown. Decurrent. Moderately close/distant.

Spores: White. Elliptic, smooth, hyaline.

Stalk: 0.6 – 1 " x 1/8" [1.6 – 2.5 cm x 2 - 4 mm]

Dark brown/grayish-brown. Nearly equal.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: HENPV.

Notes: Microbank 331295. Henryton specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem. According to K&M (103), this species is parasitic on moss.

Synonyms: Omphalina epichysium.
