ID: Deep red; convex; dry; stalk similar; dark red pores blue when bruised.

Habitat: Solitary, scattered, groups. On ground in coniferous or mixed woods.

Cap: 2.4 – 3.8" [6 – 12 cm]

Dark red/deep wine red. Convex (broadly convex in age). Dry (finely appressed hairs when young). Disc cracked in age. Flesh yellow (quickly bluing).

Pores: Dark red (dingier in age), bluing when bruised. Circular (1 – 2/mm). Tubes (8 – 20 mm).

Spores: *Olive-brown*.

Stalk: 2.4 – 3.1" x 0.4 – 1.1" [6 – 8 cm x 1 – 3 cm]

Dark red, yellow at apex, bluing when bruised. Dark red reticulation over upper portion. Solid.

Frequency: Occasional.

Locations: BRNBR, PIGTL, SVMLT.

Notes: Mycobank 309682.

Synonym: *Boletus rubroflammeus*
