ID: Red w/ olive-yellow tints; margin incurved. Blues. Use KOH and NH₄OH.

Habitat: Solitary. Mixed woods.

Cap: 2 – 6" [5 – 15 cm]

Red/rosy-red (rosy-tan w/ olive-yellow tints in age). Convex (broadly convex/flat in age). Dry. Margin incurved at first. Flesh white/yellowish. Blues when cut (sometimes slowly).

Pores: Yellow (dingy olive in age). Quickly bluing (then stain brown). Circular/angular (1 – 2/mm). Tubes (6 – 16 mm).

Spores: Olive-brown.

Stalk: 2.4 – 5" x 3/8 – 3/4" 3/4– 12.5 cm 1 – 2 cm]

Yellow (or w/ reddish/brownish tinges). Dry. Solid. Blues when handled.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: MANWD.

Notes: Mycobank 232787. KOH: cap olive-yellow, then olive-green/olive-bronze; flesh pale orange. NH₄OH: cap orange-yellow/red-brown; flesh negative.
