## Frost's Bolete Apple Bolete

<u>Butyriboletus frostii</u> Boletaceae

**ID**: Cap blackish-red/bright red (fades in age); convex (flat in age); flesh yellow. Pores drab red (paler in age). Stalk reticulate, clubshaped, dark red. Cap and pores stain blue rapidly; stalk slowly.

**Habitat**: Scattered, groups. On ground in hardwood forests (especially oak).

**Cap**: 2 - 6" [5 - 15.5 cm]

Blackish-red/bright red (blood-red w/ yellowish spots in age). Whitish bloom becomes smooth (sticky when wet). Convex (flat in age). Margin inrolled when young (upturned in age). Flesh yellowish, rapidly stains blue.

**Pores**: Dark red (paler in age); often w/ yellow droplets. Rapidly stain blue. Circular (2 - 3/mm). Tubes (6 - 15 mm).

Spores: Olive-brown.

**Stalk**: 1.6 - 4.8° x 0.4 - 1° [5 - 15.5 cm x 1 - 2.5 cm]

Dark red, often yellowish/white at base. Deeply and coarsely reticulate. Club-shaped (cylindrical in age). Flesh slowly stains blue.

Frequency: Occasional.

Locations: GONRA, HAMVL, WSTRP.

**Notes:** Mycobank 818399. Ilchester E.S. specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.

Synonym: Boletus frostii. Exudoporus frostii.
