ID: Cap yellow-orange, smooth; nearly flat, slightly depressed disc. Blunt gill-like ridges.

Habitat: Scattered, groups. On ground/In moss in hardwood forests.

Cap: 0.2 – 1.1" [6 – 30 mm]

Yellow-orange/yellow (fades in age). Dry. Nearly smooth. Convex to nearly flat, slightly depressed center. Flesh orange, soft.

Fertile Surface: Orange/yellow-orange. Decurrent w/ forked blunt gill-like ridges, crossveins.

Spores: Pinkish-yellow/pale *yellowish-orange*. Ellipsoid, smooth w/ oil droplets..

Stalk: 0.6 - 2.4" [1.6 - 6 cm]

Pale yellow/yellow-orange. Smooth. Thick at top, tapers down.

Frequency: Abundant.
