ID: Body white, fuzzy and dome-shaped.

Habitat: Clusters. On well-decayed logs.

Fruiting Body: Up to 0.4" long [1 cm]
Dome-shaped, honeycombed. White, fuzzy appearance.

Stalk: Short (if visible).

Spores: *White*. Round or ellipsoid, rough.

Frequency: Abundant--after prolonged rainy periods.

Locations: BENBR, BIGBR, BOLPL, BRNBR, CASCT, CEDLP, DANPV, FRANF, GONRA, HENPV, HIRIP, HOUC, LONGC, MANWD, MCHPV, MCLUR, MPENA, MTPLT, MURHL, NOFRP, OTHER, PATRP, PIGTL, RKBPR, ROBNC, ROGOR, SLMLP, TRIRS, UMDCF, WDKPV, WSKPV, WSTRP, WINTR.

Notes: Mycobank 461893. Woodstpck, PVSP, specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.
