

ID: Small yellow/green cups on wood; stalkless.

Habitat: Groups/clusters on decaying hardwood (oak). Often stains substrate (wood) blue-green.

Fruiting Body: 1/32 - 1/8" [1 – 3 mm]

Outer surface: yellow, rough. Fertile surface: Light yellow (shades of green in age. Cup-shaped w/ inrolled margin/almost flat. Stalkless.

Spores: Fusiform, smooth, hyaline.

Frequency: Fairly common.

Locations: CEDLP, MCHPV, MTPLT, MURHL, SLMLP, WINTR.

Notes: Mycobank 528809. Morning Choice Trail, PVSP, Mount Pleasant, and Schooley Mill Park records identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.
