ID: Body white, tips may yellow in age; worm-like/cylindrical.

Habitat: ttered, groups, clusters. On ground in forests/grass.

Fruiting Body: Up to 4.5" H x 1/16 – 3/8" W
 [11.5 cm x 1.5 – 6 mm] Pure white (tips may yellow in age). Flesh white, soft, brittle. Hollow in age.

Spores: *White*. Ellipsoid, smooth, hyaline.

Frequency: Very common.

Locations: BIGBR, BRNBR, CASCT, CEDLP, DANPV, GONRA, HENPV, HIRIP, LONGC, MANWD, MCHPV, MPENA, MURHL, OTHER, PIGTL, ROBNC, SLMLP, WSTRP, WINTR.
