**ID:** Reddish-buff club w/ wrinkled (usually heavily wrinkled) head; stem blends into fertile surface. Use KOH.

**Habitat:** Solitary, groups. On ground in hardwoods (hickory-oak) or pine forests.

**Fruiting Body:** 1.2 – 3.9" high X 0.8 – 2.4" wide [3 – 10 x 2 – 6 cm]  
 Fruiting body vertically wrinkled/grooved; tapes up to wrinkled (sometimes heavily wrinkled) head. Reddish-buff (cinnamon-brown in age or bruised); may have violet-brown tones. Flesh white, firm/spongy; slowly turns brownish when cut.

**Stalk:** Not easily distinguished from rest of fruiting body. Up to 1.2" [4 cm] may be buried. White at base w/ radiating white cords.

**Spores:** *White*. Ellipsoid, smooth, hyaline.

**Frequency:** Uncommon.

**Locations:** GONRA.

**Notes:** Mycobank 294980. KOH turns top yellow. Gorman Stream Valley NRA specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.
