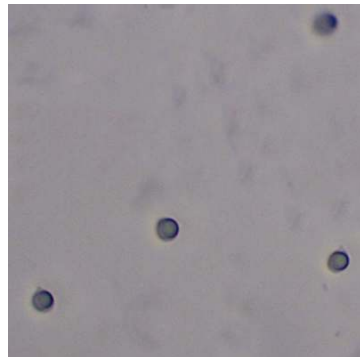

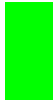

ID: Body deep reddish-orange; cylindrical, seldom branched w/ longitudinal grooves.

Habitat: Loose to compact clusters. On ground in forests.

Fruiting Body: Up to 5" H x 1/16 – 3/8" W [12 cm x 1.5 – 10 mm]
Deep reddish-orange/paler pinkish-orange, base may be whiter. Smooth (or top wrinkled), cylindrical/somewhat flattened, tip pointed (rounded/blunt in age). Flesh yellowish, thin, brittle to fibrous. Hollow. Longitudinal grooves.

Spores: *White/pale yellow*. Nearly round, smooth, hyaline.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: FRANF, MANWD, MCHPV, MURHL, PIGTL, RKBRP, SLMLP, SYRIV.
