ID: Cap gray-brown; convex (depressed in age). Base bulbous/ club-shaped. Aromatic.

Habitat: Solitary, scattered, groups. On ground in coniferous and hardwood forests.

Cap: 0.8 - 3.5" [2 - 9 cm]

Gray-/olive-brown, margin paler (buff in age). Moist. Smooth/felty/ir-regular; may have matted fibers. Convex becoming flat w/ depressed disc (w/ or w/o umbo). Margin elevated and wavy in age. Flesh whitish/ watery-gray, limp in wet weather, brittle in dry. Spicy odor.

Gills: Whitish, pale yellowish/cream in age. Decurrent. Close/subdistant, often forked/crossveined. Depth 2 mm. Secondary gills.

Spores: White. Oval, smooth, hyaline.

Stalk: 1.4 - 2.4" x 0.1 - 0.6" [3.6 - 6 cm x 4 - 15 mm] Whitish w/longitudinal olive-gray fibrils. Tapers up. Base bulbous/club-shaped, often w/ white mycelium.


Frequency: Occasional.

Locations: ANNRK, NOLAP, RKBRP, ROGOR.

Notes: Mycobank 169780. Annapolis Rock record verified by examination of spores by R. Solem.
