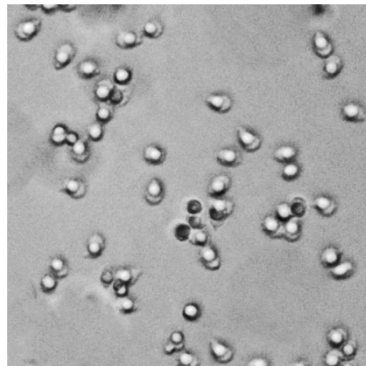


White Coral

**ID:** White coral repeatedly branched from small base; pale apricot in age.

**Habitat:** Solitary, scattered. In forests on ground.

**Fruiting Body:** 0.8 – 2.4" [2 – 6 cm]

White (pinkish/pale apricot tinge in age). Smooth. Erect and repeatedly branched, arising from a short stalk. Flesh white, brittle/flexible.

**Spores:** *White*. Nearly round, minutely spined, hyaline, apiculus.

**Frequency:** Occasional.

**Locations:** BRNBR, DANPV, GONRA, MANWD, PIGTL, RKBRP, WINTR.

**Notes:** Mycobank 338194. Gorman Stream Valley NRA specimen identified by examination of spores by *R. Solem*.
