White (brownish in age). Smooth. Convex. Margin inrolled.

**Stalk**: 1/8 – 1/4" [5 - 10 mm]. White. Equal.

**Spores**: *Hyaline*. Fusiform/one side flatter, hyaline.

Frequency: Occasional.

Locations: CEDLP, MCHPV. SYRIV.
