

Golden-scruffy Collybia

Cyptotrama asprata [or near] Physalacriaceae

D

ID: Cap bright yellow, covered w/ fibrils. Stalk same color.

Habitat: Scattered. On hardwood sticks/logs (oak).

Cap: 1/4 - 1" [0.5 - 2.5 cm]

Bright yellow/golden. Convex/broadly convex. Granular/fibril coated; often wrinkled/furrowed in age. Margin pressed against stalk at first. Flesh pale yellowish.

Gills: White. Attached/slightly decurrent. Broad. Distant.

Spores: White.

Stalk: 1 - 2" x 1/16 - 1/8" [1 - 5 cm x 1.5 - 3 mm]Golden w/ pale yellow background. Scurfy. Solid. Tough.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: ROBNC.
