ID: Cap bright yellow, covered w/ fibrils. Stalk same color.

Habitat: Scattered. On hardwood sticks/logs (oak).

Cap: 1/4 – 1" [0.5 – 2.5 cm]

Bright yellow/golden. Convex/broadly convex. Granular/fibril coated; often wrinkled/furrowed in age. Margin pressed against stalk at first. Flesh pale yellowish.

Gills: White. Attached/slightly decurrent. Broad. Distant.

Spores: *White*.

Stalk: 1 – 2" x 1/16 – 1/8" [1 – 5 cm x 1.5 – 3 mm]

Golden w/ pale yellow background. Scurfy. Solid. Tough.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: ROBNC.
