ID: Dense, overlapping clusters. On debarked hardwood.

Habitat: Debarked hardwood.

Fruiting Body: 0.4 – 4” [1 – 10 cm]

White/ivory (yellowish/brownish/pinkish/purplish in age). Irregular, gelatinous lobes fused into large globs.

Spores: Sausage-shaped, smooth.

Frequency: Very common.

Locations: BIGBR, CASCT, DANPV, FRANF, GONRA, GWACP, HENPV, HIRIP, LONGC, MURHL, MPENA, PIGTL, ROBNC, SUKBR, SVMLT, WINTR, WSKPV.

Notes: Mycobank 297040. Robinson Nature Center (6/15/2009) specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem
