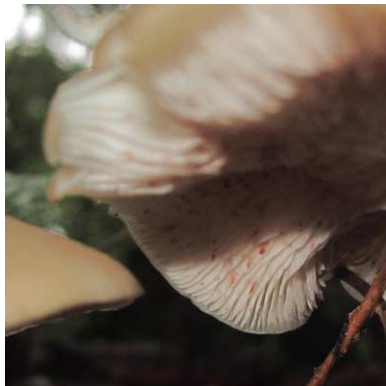

ID: Cap brownish-gray/buff. Conic w/ tiny umbo.

Habitat: Scattered, groups. In moss/on humus in very damp forests.

Cap: 1.2 – 3.5" [3 – 9 cm]

Brownish gray (wet); buff (dry). Convex w/ central bump (nearly flat in age). Silky (dry). Margin faintly striate (wet). Flesh whitish/grayish.

Gills: Whitish gray (pink in age). Almost free. Close.

Spores: *Cinnamon*. Angular, 5-/6-sided, generally smooth.

Stalk: 1.2 – 3.5" x 1/16 – 0.5" [3 –9 cm x 4 – 12 mm]
Whitish. Equal. Hollow. White mycelium.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: HAMVL.

Notes: Mycobank 313819. Hammond Village record verified by examination of spores by R. Solem. Incorrectly described as *E. griseum* (Peck) Hesler.
