**ID**: Brown/tan, conic/bell-shaped; grayish-pink/-brown gills; brown stalk.

**Habitat**: Solitary, scattered, on ground in mixed woods. Acid, sandy soil, often in moss.

**Cap**: 1 - 2" [2.5 - 5 cm]

Dark brown (tan in age), conic/bell-shaped (more convex in age), retaining nipple-shaped umbo in most specimens. Smooth (almost greasy). Flesh pale brown.

Gills: Grayish to pinkish-brown, attached, subdistant, broad.

**Stalk**: 1.5 - 3.1" x 1/8 - 3/8" [4 - 8 cm x 3 - 10 mm]

Brown, scurfy-fibrous, often twisted; base w/ white mycelium.

**Spores**: Salmon-pink.

Frequency: Fairly common.

Locations: BENBR, GONRA, MPENA, PIGTL, RKBRP, ROGOR.

Notes: Mycobank 281570. Synonym: *Nolanea verna*.
