Habitat: Indian Grass (*Sorghastrum nutans*).

Fruiting body: “The dark brain-like structures on this grass are the sporodochia of *Cerebella andropogonis* which is a hyphomycete in the Pleosporales. The insert shows the asexual conidia. Thanks goes to Bonnie Ott for first pointing out this grass disease to me and Megan Romberg (USDA-APHIS) for the identification. On Indian Grass (*Sorghastrum nutans*).”*
