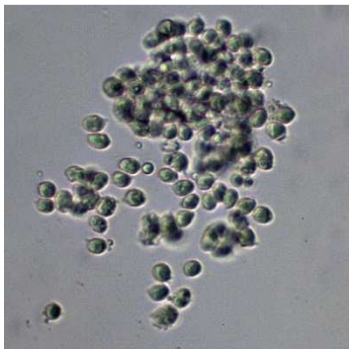

**ID:** Blackish/brown viscid cap w/ translucent margin.

**Habitat:** Solitary, clustered. On soil or moss in hardwood or conifer forests.

**Cap:** 0.8 – 2" [2 – 5 cm]

Blackish-brown (grayish-brown in age). Hemispheric (convex in age). Viscid/glutinous. Margin translucent.

**Gills:** White/grayish-white. Attached..Thick, waxy.

**Spores:** *White*.Ellipsoid, smooth.

**Stalk:** 1 – 2.5" x 0.1 – 0.2" [2.5 –6. 5 cm x 2 – 5 mm]

Color of cap. Round or compressed. Equal. Hollow in age.

**Frequency:** Uncommon.

**Locations:** HIRIP.

**Notes:** Mycobank 550234. High Ridge Park specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.

**Synonym** *Hygrocybe unguinosa*. *Hygrocybe irrigata* .
