

ID: Small glutinous waxcap; may be various colors.

Habitat: Scattered, groups. On ground in mixed woods (often in mosses), on damp soil.

Cap: 0.2 - 2" [1 - 5 cm]

Variable (shell-pink/peach, orange-red/olive-orange, yellow-gray, yellow, cream. Convex (flat in age w/ depresseed center). Glutinous/sticky when fresh (shiny/smooth when dry). Margin striate. Flesh thin. Peculiar (foul) odor.

Gills: Color variable like cap. Sticky. Attached/decurrent. Distant. Narrow.

Spores: White. Oval, smooth, hyaline.

Stalk: 0.6 - 3.1" x 1/8 - 1/4" [1.5 - 8 cm x 1.5 - 6 mm]

Colored like cap. Glutinous. Hollow.

Frequency: Fairly common..

Locations: FRANF, GONRA, HIRIP, MANWD, OTHER, savpk, WINTR.

Notes: Mycobank 103375. *Index Fungorum* and Mycobank disagree on preferred name. Mycobank 357286: *Hygrocybe laeta* (Persoon) P. Kummer. Gorman Stream Valley NRA specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.
