ID: Dense, overlapping clusters. On debarked hardwood.

Habitat: Debarked hardwood.

Fruiting Body: 0.4 – 4" [1 – 10 cm]

White/ivory/tinged w/ pink-violet (stains purple/yellow/brownish in age). Irregular, fuses into brain-like masses often covering length of log.

Frequency: Common.

Locations: BIGBR, CASCT, DANPV, GONRA, HENPV, HIRIP, LONGC, MPENA, PIGTL, SUKBR, SVMLT.
