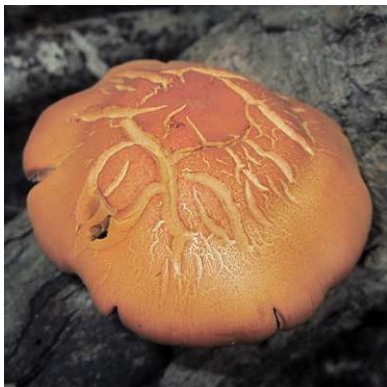

**ID:** Orange/rusty-brown cap; gills yellowish, attached.

**Habitat:** Scattered, groups. Rotting (even punky) wood of fallen hardwoods

**Cap:** 0.8 – 3.1" [2 – 8 cm]

Orange/rusty-brown. Convex (flat in age). Margin finely lined in age. Flesh pale yellow/orange. Odor mild. Taste bitter.

**Gills:** Yellowish/pale orange (orange in age). Attached. Close. No veil.

**Spores:** *Rusty-brown*, Ellipsoid, roughened; reddish brown in KOH; finely echinulate. Cheilocystidia up to about 20 [ $\mu$ m] long; cylindric with capitate to subcapitate apices. Pleurocystidia inconspicuous, basidiole-like; scattered; similar (Dr. M. Kuo, *pers. comm.*).

**Stalk:** 1.2 – 2.8" x 1/16 – 0.4" [3 – 7 cm x 1 – 8 mm]

Whitish/pale orange (darker in age). Nearly equal; may be off-center. Mycelium yellow or rusty.

**Frequency:** Uncommon.

**Locations:** BOLPL, ROGOR.

**Notes:** Mycobank 415197. Bollman Place record identified by Dr. M. Kuo by examination of specimen (*pers. comm.*). Scott's Cove, Rocky Gorge, specimen verified by examination of spores by R. Solem. KOH turns cap dark red.
