ID: Distinctive fuzzy, swollen knob at point of attachment. Use KOH.

Habitat: Scattered, groups, clusters. On hardwood twigs, logs, and stumps.

Cap: 0.4 – 2.0" [1 – 5 cm]
Orangish/reddish-brown (pinkish-buff to tan in age). Convex w/ incurved margin; flat in age w/ radial wrinkles and lined margin. Flesh whitish, thin, tough.

Gills: Whitish/pinkish-buff (spotted reddish-brown in age). Narrowly attached/nearly free.

Stalk: 0.4 – 2.0" X 0.2" {1 – 5 cm X 5 mm]
Buff above, color of cap below. Distinctive fuzzy, swollen knob at point of attachment.

Spores: White.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: MCHPV.

Notes: Mycobank 437621. KOH olive on cap surface. Identified by macrocharacteristics only.
