ID: Cap creamy buff w/ gray bloom, hygrophanous (flat in age).

Habitat: Groups. On ground in conifer and mixed forests.

Cap: 0.8 – 2.4" [2 – 6 cm]

Creamy-buff w/ gray bloom (yellowish, reddish-brown in age); hygrophanous (darkens). Convex. Remains of veil on margin when young. Flesh cream/yellowish.

Gills: Pale cream (ochre-rusty in age). Attached w small decurrent tooth.

Spores: *Light-brown*.

Stalk: 1.6 — 2.4" x 0.4 – 0.6" [4 – 6 cm x 10 – 14 mm]

Whitish-cream (bruises yellowish then reddish). Fibrous.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: WSTRP.

Notes: Mycobank 502514.

Synonym: *Cortinarius communis*
