ID: Peridium mustard-yellow and cottony in a shallow cup w/ short stalk. Young reddish.

Habitat: Dense clusters. On well-decayed logs/ stumps.

Fruiting Body: 1/32 – 1/8" [1 – 3 mm]

Mustard-/olive-yellow. Outer wall disappears, peridium expands to form club-shaped, cottony head supported by shallow, membranous cup (cal-yculus). Young reddish, smooth; on short stalk.

Stalk: Dark red-brown.

Spores: Dull yellow. Nearly round, slightly reticulate, hyaline.

Frequency: Fairly common.

Locations: DANPV, DFWMA, MCHPV, MPENA, OTHER, PIGTL, SLMLP, TRIRS, WDKPV, WINTR, WSTRP.
