**ID**: Cap tan/pale brown; fan-/funnel-shaped/decurrent. Stubby stalk.

**Habitat**: Solitary, groups, clusters. On ground, on or near woody debris/mulch.

**Cap**: 1 - 3" [2.5 - 7.5 cm]

Tan/pale brown/grayish-brown. Minutely hairy to smooth. Fan-shaped/somewhat funnel-shaped. Flesh white, thin, gelatinous.

**Gills**: White to yellow-brown. Sometimes decurrent to base of stalk. Crowded. Narrow; minutely fringed edges. Depth = 2X cap flesh. Secondary gills.

Stalk: Lateral. Whitish, hairy. Short, stubby.


**Spores**: White. Ellipsoid, smooth.

Frequency: Occasional.

Locations: BRNBR, MPENA, ROGOR, SAVPK.
