
Hygrophoropsis aurantiaca (Wulfen) Maire

ID: Cap orange, disc darker; funnel-shaped in age; margin inrolled.

**Habitat**: Solitary, scattered, groups. On wood/needles/duff/other conifer debris; also found on hardwood debris.

**Cap**: 0.8 - 3" [2 - 7.5 cm]

False Chanterelle

Orange overall, sometimes yellow/orange brown, disc darker. Dry/slightly moist; minutely velvety/rather smooth. Flat-topped (funnel-shaped in age). Margin inrolled (may remain so). Flesh orangish.

**Fertile Surface**: Pale orangish-yellow/deep orange. Decurrent, narrow but typically w/ thickened blunt edges; regularly forked. Close/almost crowded.

Spores: White. Ellipsoid, smooth, hyaline.

**Stalk**: 1 - 4" x 0.2 - 0.8" [2.5 - 10 cm x 6 - 20 mm] Central/off-center/almost lateral. Orange overall; usually finely hairy. Dry. Curved, tapers up. Flesh orangish; fairly tough.

Frequency: Fairly common.

Locations: FRANF, LONGC, MPENA, ROBNC, ROGOR, WSTRP.
