

ID: Cap yellow-orange; convex.

Habitat: Scattered, clusters. On conifer logs/stumps only.

## **Cap**: 1 – 2.8" [2.5 – 7 cm]

Yellow-orange/reddish-orange/orange-cinnamon. Dry/moist (greasy, not sticky). Convex/broadly convex. Margin typically w/ white veil remnants. Flesh white.

Gills: Grayish (never white; purple-brown in age). Attached. Close.

**Spores**: Purple-brown/*purple*. Ellipsoid/ovate w/ distinct pore.

**Stalk**: 2 - 4" x 1/8 - 3/8" [5 - 10 cm x 3 - 10 mm] Whitish/yellow (rusty brown from base upward in age). Fibrillose. Cylindrical/tapered upward. Partial veil usually leaves annular zone. Hollow in age.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: ORRBB, RKBRP.

**Notes**: Mycobank 159037. Rockburn Branch Park specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.

Synonym: Naematoloma capnoides.
