## J F M A M J J A S O N D

**ID**: Body color varies, blackening in age; surface bumpy. Use KOH.

**Habitat**: Infects bark of various hardwoods; species are specific to each hardwood.

**Fruiting Body**: 1/16–5/8" x 1/16–3/8" [1.5–15 mm x 1.5–10 mm] Color varies w/ species, all blacken in age. Flesh black, hard. Surface minutely bumpy. Perithecia just below surface.

Frequency: Common.

**Cushion Hypoxylon** 

**Locations**: BIGBR, CASCT, DANPV, FRANF, FULSA, GONRA, MPENA, MCHPV, PIGTL, ROBNC, SLMLP, SVMLT, SYRIV, UMDCF, WSTRP, ZIRNP.

**Notes**: References are all to specific species. KOH releases variously colored pigments depending on the species. There are now two genera that appear identical to the naked eye: *Hypoxylon* and *Annulohypolylon*. (They differ in the construction of the perithecia.)
