**ID:** Shaggy dull brown cap and stalk. Use KOH.

**Habitat:** Scattered, groups. Sandy soil under conifers/mixed woods.

**Cap:** 0.4 – 1.5" [1 – 4 cm]

Dull brown (tawny in age). Fibrillose to scaly. Margin often ragged/torn. Flesh whitish.

**Gills:** Whitish (grayish-brown in age). Attached/notched.

**Spores:** *Brown*. Cylindrical, smooth.

**Stalk:** 1.1 – 2.4" x 1/8 – 1/2" [3 – 6 cm x 3 – 6 mm]  
Grayish-brown, fibrillose. Dry.

**Frequency:** Uncommon.

**Locations:** BIGBR, PIGTL.

**Notes:** Mycobank 244397. Big Branch (9/2/2014 & 6/26/2016) specimens identified by examination of spores by R. Solem. KOH turns cap gray.
