ID: Cap pinkish-brown; striate, margin undulate. Gills pale pink. Stalk color of cap.

Habitat: Scattered, groups. On sandy or bare soil in damp woods in floodplain, often on banks of streams or ponds.

Cap: 1.5 – 2.8" [0.5 – 1.5 cm]

Pale pinkish-brown/more reddish. Dry. Scurfy. Depressed/almost funnel-shaped. Margin flesh-pink, undulate, striate when wet. Flesh = gill layer.

Gills: Pale pink; waxy. Attached. Broad. Distant.

Spores: *White*.

Stalk: 0.2 – 0.6" x 1/32 – 3/32" [4 – 14 mm x 1 – 2 mm]

Color of cap. Base covered w/ white mycelium. Hollow.

Frequency: Occasional.

Locations: BIGBR, MPENA, PIGTL.
