ID: Body cup-shaped, white, hairy, tiny.

Habitat: Dense clusters. On hardwoods (especially oak).

Fruiting Body: 1/16 – 1/8" [1.5 – 4 mm] Cup shaped w/ tiny stalk; often looks crumpled. <u>Fertile surface</u>: White/cream, smooth. <u>Infertile surface</u>: White w/ dense white hairs (often w/ water drops).

Ascospores: Hyaline. Smooth, elliptic/fusoid, hyaline.

Frequency: Fairly common.

Locations: BOLPL, CEDLP, DANPV, GONRA, MCHPV, MPENA, MTPLT, PATBT, SAVPK.

Notes: Mycobank 356658. MPEA specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem. Most references dscribe it on twigs and branches. All Howard County records were on logs or stumps. Identification provided by A. E. Bessette (*pers. comm.*)
