ID: Greenish cap/flat/depressed; scurfy; margin incurved.

Habitat: Solitary, scattered. In conifer and mixed forests.

Cap: 2.4 – 5.6" [6 – 15 cm]

Various shades of green (olive to dark). Broadly convex (flat w/ depressed disc in age). Dry. Scurfy/minutely scaly/pitted. Margin remains incurved. Latex white, stains gills greenish; taste acrid.

Gills: Whitish/pinkish (bruise olive-brown). Attached/subdecurrent. Close.

Spores: *White*/pale cream.

Stalk: 0.8 – 3.1" x 0.4 – 1.1" [2 – 8 cm x 1 – 3 cm]

Color of cap. Dry. Equal. Hollow.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: PIGTL.
