Habitat: Solitary, scattered, groups. On ground in deciduous or mixed

Cap: 0.8 - 4.8" [2 - 12 cm]

Dark red/bright apple red (brick red/rusty rose in age). Convex (flatter in age). Flesh yellow/pale yellow. Blues near stalk Odd odor.

Pores: Orange red/red, stain greenish blue (in age, brownish red and sometimes depressed near stalk). Tubes 6-10 mm.

Spores: Olive-brown. Subfusoid, smooth, pale yellow.

Stalk: 2-4" x 0.4-0.8" [5 – 10 cm x 1 – 2 cm]

Color of cap. Only reticulate at apex. Flesh yellow/pale yellow, slowly blues at apex; vinaceous brown at base.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: DANPV.
