ID: Fuzzy white hairs on shell-shaped body; usually clustered.

Habitat: Overlapping clusters. Decaying hardwood trees, logs, stumps.

Cap: 2 – 4.5" [5 – 11.5 cm]

Pale pinkish/cinnamon ground color, covered w/ dense short white hairs. Shell-shaped or convex. Velvety/fuzzy. Margin inrolled at first. Thin flesh dull white w/ pinkish/brownish tints. Taste acrid.

Gills: Whitish (pale pinkish-cinnamon in age). Decurrent to attachment point. Edges serrate; often torn. Close.

Spores: *White*. Nearly round, tiny spines.

Stalk: Less than 2" [5 cm] or lacking

If present: pinkish-brown; stout, tapers down, fused w/ others in common base; velvety/fuzzy.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: MANWD.

Notes: Mycobank 255456. Manor Woods E.S. specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.
