ID: Cap white w/ cinnamon-brown scales. Small white ring. Stalk cylindrical (may be bulbous at base).

Habitat: Scattered, groups. On ground or decayed wood in forests (conifers).

Cap: 0.4 - 2.8" [1 - 7 cm]

White w/ cinnamon-brown scales. Dry. Smooth (but shows concentric rings of brown scales in age). Convex (broadly convex/nearly flat in age, sometimes w/ small umbo). Flesh white; odor unpleasant/spicy/absent.

Gills: White; edges sometime toothed. Nearly free. Close. Narrow.

Spores: White/green.

Stalk: 0.8 - 3.1" x 1/8 - 1/4" [2 - 6 cm x 2 - 6 mm] White/pale pinkish-buff; often brownish at base. Smooth. Cylindrical/sometimes bulbous at base; hollow in age. White partial veil leaves persistent, small, white ring.

Frequency: Fairly common.
