
Smooth Parasol

ID: Cap white/grayish, smooth/slightly rough w/ small scales; eggshaped (convex/ nearly flat in age). Stalk white (may stain yellow); double-edged ring, often moveable.

Habitat: Scattered, groups. Grassy areas.

Cap: 2 – 4.8" [5 – 12 cm]

White/dull-white/grayish; sometimes stains yellow. Dry. Smooth/slight roughness w/ small scales. Egg-shaped (convex/nearly flat in age). Margin w/ partial veil remnants. Flesh white/tan (not staining).

Gills: White, pinkish/grayish/pale brown in age. Free, close, broad.

Spores: White/gray/cream.

Stalk: 2 - 4.8" x 0.4 - 0.8" [5 - 12 cm x 1 - 2 cm] White; may stain yellow. Dry. Partial veil leaves double-edged ring (often moveable). Stuffed (hollow in age).

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: CEDLP, RKBRP.
