Cap: 0.8 - 4.2" [2 - 10.5 cm]

Bright/pale yellow, smooth or powdery scales. Umbo (usually). Becomes conic/bell-shaped (flat in age). Margin striate. Flesh yellow; thin.

Gills: Yellow/pale yellow. Free. Crowded.

Spores: White.

Stalk: 1.2 – 4" x 1/16 – 1/5" [3 – 10 cm x 1 – 5 mm]

Bright yellow. Powdery (like cap). Partial veil leaves moveable ring.
