ID: Cap white/gray w/ slimy veil; convex (flatter in age). Stalk whitish; ring may not persist.

Habitat: Alone, scattered. On ground in mixed forests and wet areas.

Cap: 1 – 3" [2.5 – 7.5 cm]

Whitish/gray, darker disc, slimy veil. Convex/flat.

Gills: Whitish. Attached, slightly decurrent. Crowded. Narrow.

Spores: *White*.

Stalk: 3 – 4" x 3/8 – 5/8" [7.5 – 10 cm x 1 – 1.5 cm]

White/gray. Smooth/finely hairy, often w/ remains of ring. Swollen base. Solid.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: MPENA.
