ID: Body white w/ pyramidal warts, light tan/grayish in age w/ large pore/tear. Spores white/yellowish, brown at maturity.

Habitat: Groups (several to many). On ground in grassy areas in pastures/open woods.

Fruiting Body: 1.6 – 2.4” x 2 – 4” [4 – 6 cm x 5 – 10 cm]
 White when young w/ scurfy surface/pyramidal warts, becoming light tan/yellowish, then grayish tint in age; large pore (or tear) at maturity. Spherical/egg-shaped w/ tapering rhizomorph extending into ground.

Spores: Gleba white when young, yellowish, then *brown* at maturity.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: MTPLT.

Notes: Mytcobank 499405.

Synonym: *Bovistella radicata*.

Notes: Fruiting body in Photo 1, <2 cm; Photos 2–3, 4 cm (one day later); Photo 4, smallest 1 cm, largest 4 cm. Photo 5, spores 1000x (R Orr).
