

ID: Pale ochre/white. Stalk black from base up; smooth, hollow. Abundant in wet weather.

Habitat: Groups, clusters. On deciduous (oak) leaves and twigs.,

Cap: 0.3 - 1.5 " [1 – 4 cm]

Pale ochre (soon white). Convex (nearly flat in age). Somewhat wrinkled. Odor varies from mild to foul. No collar.

Gills: White, widely spaced. Notched. Secondary gills.

Spores: White. Ellipsoid, smooth, taper to point at one end..

Stalk: 0.4 - 1.6° x 1/32 - 1/8° [1 - 4 cm x 1 - 3 mm]

Yellowish (soon darkens from base up to dark brown/black). Dry. Smooth,

Equal. Hollow. Extensive white mycelium at base.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: CEDLP.

Notes: Mycobank 239696. Cedar Lane Park specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.
