ID: Orangish-brown (fades to yellowish-white), tiny, convex, grooved.

Habitat: Groups. Dead grass blades (after rain or in dew).

Cap: 1/8 – 3/8" [3 – 10 mm]

Orange/brown/reddish-brown (fades to yellowish-white). Convex, grooved, tiny depression in center. Flesh very thin.

Gills: White/yellowish, may have brownish edges. Attached to collar (or stalk). Distant.

Spores: White (if you can get them).

Stalk: 0.6 – 1.2" x ~1/100" [1.5 – 3.5 cm x 0.1 – 0.5 mm]

May be yellowish-white at top, mostly reddish-/blackish-brown below. Black attachment to substrate.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: DANPV.
