ID: Cap bright pinkish-brown, smooth and dry, revives when wet; convex, margin grooved. Stalk black, wiry.

Habitat: Scattered, groups. On ground in forests.

Cap: 1/8 –1/2" [4 – 12 mm]

Bright pinkish-brown/red-brown. Dry (reviving when wet). Smooth. Convex/bell-shaped, grooved. Flesh thin.

Gills: Whitish. Attached. Narrow. Distant.

Spores: *White*. Teardrop-shaped, smooth, hyaline.

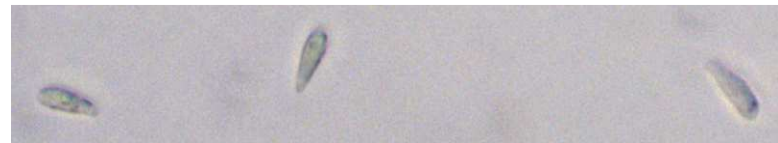
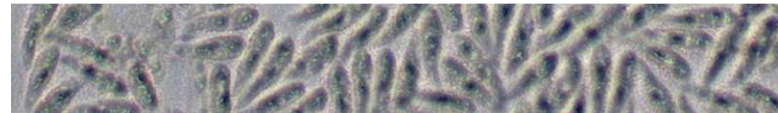
Stalk: Up to 2" x ca. 1/32" [5 cm x 0.3 – 1 mm]
 Black. Wiry.

Frequency: Common.

Locations: CEDLP, DANPV, GONRA, MCHPV, OTHER, PIGTL, SAVPK, SLMLP, SUKBR, TUFTS, WSKPV, WSTRP.

Notes: Mycobank 157758. Western Regional Park and Gorman Stream Valley NRA specimens identified by examination of spores by *R. Solem*.
