
Orange-yellow Marasmius

ID: Light yellow to tan, convex, margin uplifted in age. Gills white/ pale orangish-yellow.

Habitat: Scattered, groups. Decaying deciduous leaves.

Cap: 0.8 – 2.5 " [2 – 6.5 cm]

Light yellow/orangish in spots at edge (tan in age). Moist. Convex/broadly umbonate (especially in age). Margin uplifted in age. Flesh white/ yellowish-white. Taste mild to peppery.

Gills: Yellowish-white/pale orangish-yellow. Attached but often receding. Narrow. Close/crowded. Secondary gills.

Spores: *White/cream/yellowish*. Ellipsoid, smooth, hyaline.

Stalk: 1 - 3.5" x 1/8 - 3/8" [2.5 - 8.5 cm x 3 - 9 mm] White/pale yellow. Hollow. Pale yellow/white mycelium binds to mat of leaves. No rhizomorphs.

Frequency: Occasional.

Locations: MCHPV, MURHL, WINTR, WSKPV.
